EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Amwal AlKhaleej wants to raise up to SAR2.2 billion (€414 million; \$600 million) for its third private equity fund, and for the first time is looking beyond the Middle East region for investors.

The fee structure on Fund III would be “a traditional 2 and 20” and 80 percent of the transaction fees will go back to investors, according to Jeremie Le Febvre, a partner with placement firm Triago.

Amwal AlKhaleej hired Triago to find international investors.
